The General Construction NPDES Draft Permits along with a Public Notice, supporting materials and Georgia Environmental Protection Division's (EPD's) response to stakeholder comments are now out for the public's review and comment. You have about 30 days to comment so now's the time to give your 2-cents! The draft permit and supporting documents are available by clicking here.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the determinations are invited to submit via email or in writing. Comments must be sent within 30 days of the date of the public notice (December 15, 2017).


A **BIG** CHANGE






